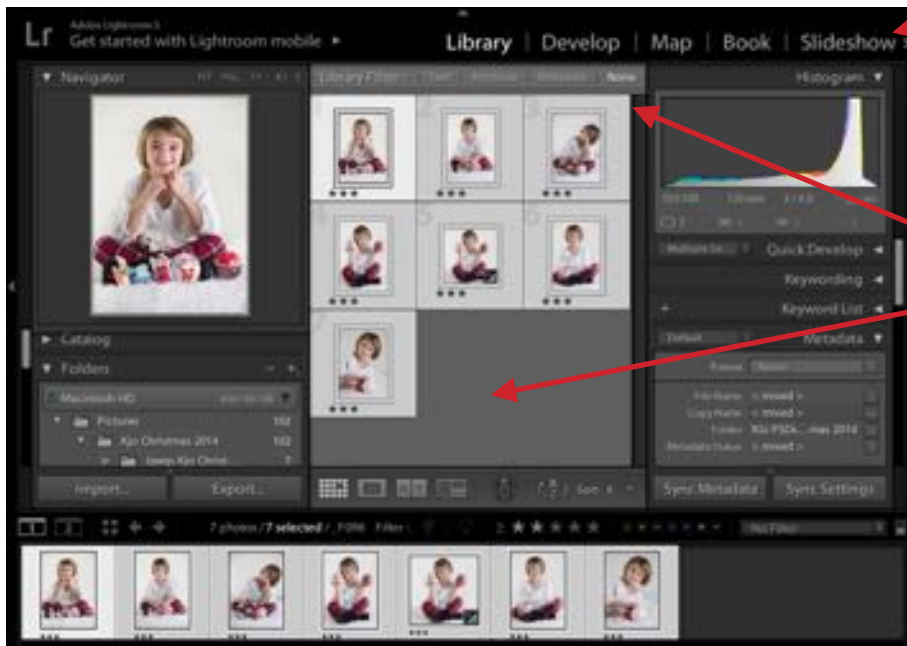


How to Create an Lightroom Slideshow

1. Choose a group of photos you want in your slide show, typically in the Library Module. Then go to the Slideshow Module.



2. Then Goto the Slideshow Module

1. Select Images in Library Module (7 Images selected - grey highlight)

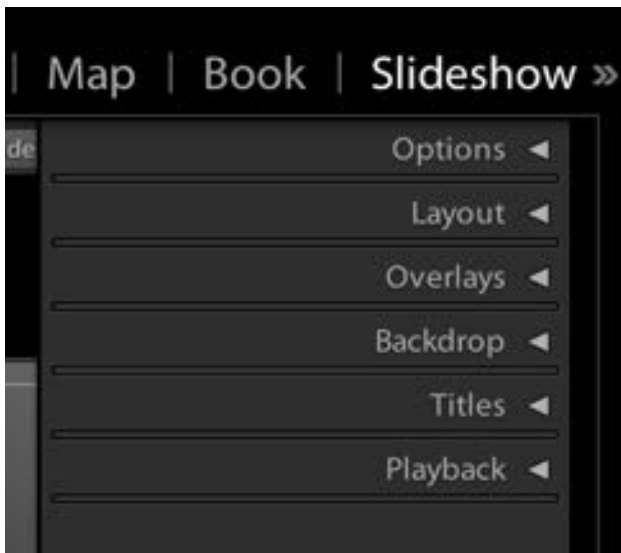
2. Within the Slideshow Module - In the Bottom Filmstrip rearrange the images in the order you want by dragging each image to the correct location

3. Within the Slideshow Module, using the RIGHT Panels :



You can change Various Options

Modify the Slideshow Layout

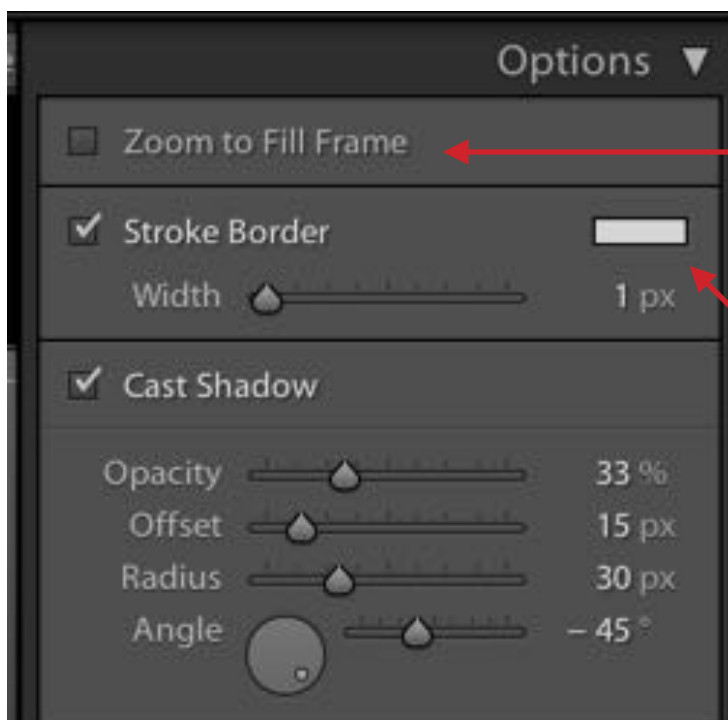
Add Text Overlays

Change the Backdrop

Add/Modify Titles

Add music using the Playback Panel

4. Right **Option Panel** allows you to Zoom Images to Fill the Frame add Stroke Border and or Cast Image shadows to images



Be careful on selecting "Zoom to Fill Frame" if you have portrait Oriented images - you may crop off part of image

Select Stroke Border Color

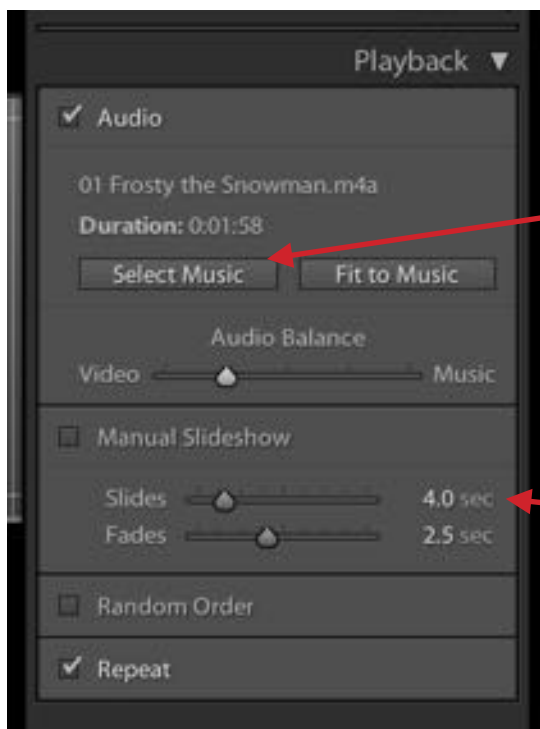
5. Right **Backdrop Panel** allows you to modify the slide background color.



Add a Color Wash and vary Opacity and Angle

Change Background Color

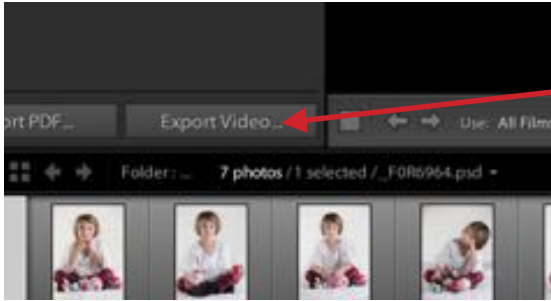
6. Using the Playback Panel You can modify Slide transitions and add music



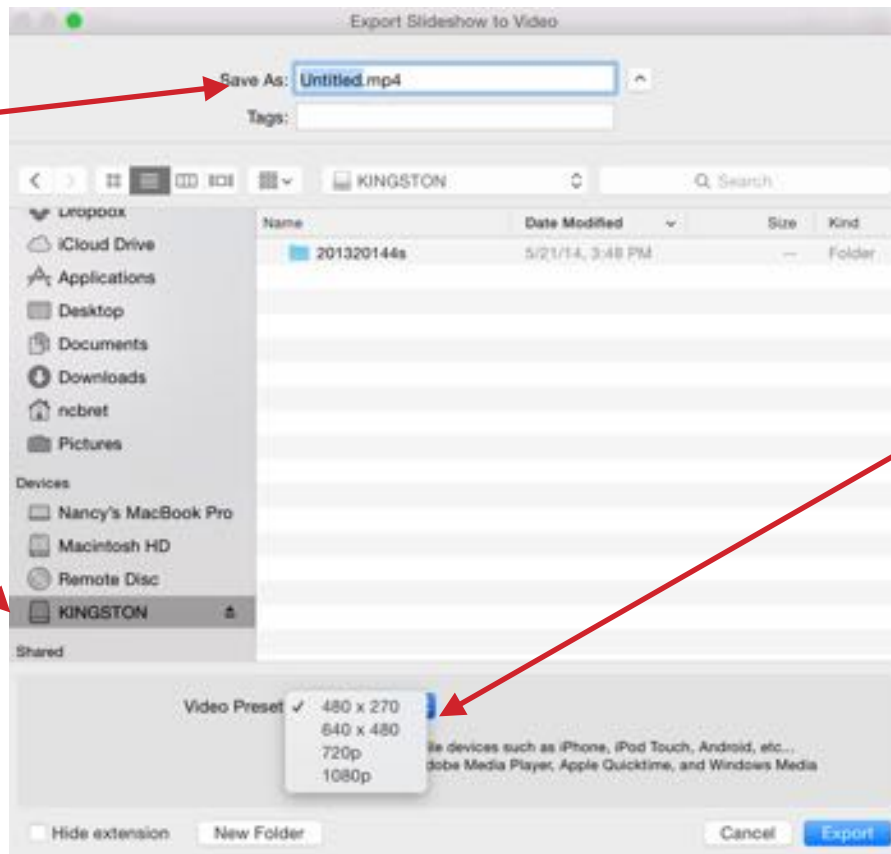
Select Music

7. Export your Slideshow using the lower Left Hand Export button
