

## Fundamentals of Digital Photography

This course will help you get better photos from your camera. We will go beyond the "automatic" settings to let you take control of your camera to create the photos you've always wanted. This course provides practical advice, in easy to understand language, so you can become a more confident photographer. It is intended for novice to intermediate photographers with a camera that has interchangeable lenses, adjustable shutter speeds and f-stops.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Introduction. Bring your camera and instruction book to all classes.
- Camera familiarization. Individual instruction on all models of cameras.
- Digital camera settings, menus and tips.
- Exposure. Understanding of shutter speeds, f-stops and ISO.
- Lenses and filters.
- Close-up photography techniques and equipment.
- Flash photography techniques, tips, and equipment.
- Tripods. Review of different types, styles, ball heads and monopods.

- Unlock your imagination to make creative photos.
- Night photography made easy, including fireworks.

The fee for this course is \$125.00. Classes will be held on 6 Saturdays starting February 17 to March 24, 2018. Time: 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

## Photoshop Digital Photo Editing

This course explains how to improve your photos on your computer. Explanations and demonstrations will be made using **Photoshop Elements**. These lessons are applicable to Photoshop as well. The non-technical presentations will help you learn fundamental skills of photo editing. Learn how to improve any photo, fix a problem photo, and turn a good photo into a prize winner. Techniques described are intended to be simple, quick and easy. Some experience with digital photo imaging would be helpful. Students using other software are welcome. This course is targeted for novice to intermediate photographers.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Digital photography file types, file management and workflow.
- Introduction to the Photoshop Elements workspace.
- Cropping and sizing.
- Adjusting lighting, contrast and color to make your photos look better.
- Working selectively with only parts of your photo for great results.
- Layers made easy. Understanding and using layers and layer masks to improve your photos.
- Resizing, sharpening and emailing photos.
- Special effects such as black & white, frames, and artistic styles.
- RAW Conversion

### Far Hills Masonic Temple 5501 Far Hills Ave. (State Rt. 48)

The lodge is just south of Rahn Rd., on the west side of Far Hills Ave, also known as State Route 48. Tobias Funeral Home is on the corner of Rahn and Far Hills. The lodge is two buildings south of the funeral home. It is adjacent to a small shopping center called Lamplighter Square. There is a large parking lot next to the lodge with an entrance from Far Hills. You can also turn onto Lamplighter Tr. which is just south of the lodge. It takes you to a back entrance to the parking lot.

To get to the lodge:

Take I-675 to the Exit 4A or 4B – (Route 48 exits )

Go north on Far Hills Ave approximately 1.5 miles

The lodge is on the left (west) side of the street just south of Rahn Rd.
